Access

Please find here below some useful instructions for easy access to Olive Green from N. Kazantzakis International Airport and the Heraklion Harbor, as well as detailed driving instructions from the eastern and western Crete.

From Heraklion Airport (Her) - Nikos Kazantzakis:

By car:

- 1. Coming out from the airport area, head right (west) towards the city centre where you meet Ikarou Avenue.
- 2. Continue straight ahead on Ikarou Avenue for about 4 km until you reach the Venetian Walls. When the road no longer continues straight but only left or right turn left.
- 3. Turn left towards the city center and after 10 meters turn right to Idomeneos Street.
- 4. After 150m Olive Green will reveal before you

By taxi:

We can arange a taxi transfer from/to the airport {20€/way}.

By bus:

Just outside the airport, opposite the arrivals area, you will find the city bus stop. The bus station in the city center of Heraklion where you should get off is the Liberty Square ("Eleftherias" square).

From there, follow the Idomeneos Street (on the left side of the stop) and after 150m you will see Olive Green right in front of you.

From Heraklion Harbour

By car:

- 1. At the traffic lights located just off the harbor, drive straight (north) the Eth. Antistasseos Avenue, until you reach traffic lights again.
- 2. Turn right on Ikarou Avenue and follow that road until the very end of it.
- 3. At the very end the Archaeological Museum will appear right in front of you.
- 4. Turnlefttowardsthecitycenterandafter10metersturnrighttoldomeneosStreet
- 5. Follow Idomeneos Street for 150m and Olive Green will reveal before you.

By taxi:

We can arange a taxi transfer from/to the airport {20€/way}...

On foot:

Olive Green in very close to Eleftherias Square which is not more than 20 minutes' walk from the Harbour.

- 1. As you leave the port, turn right, taking the coastal road until the first roundabout (Kountourioti Square).
- 2. Just across the street (next to the Venetian Shipyards) there are stairs leading to Epimenidou Street.
- 3. Alternatively, to avoid the stairs, having stepped across the roundabout, just before the stairs, move

left with direction uphill to the Doukos Bofor Street.

- 4. Turn right, walk on Epimenidou St. for 100 meters until you meet Idomeneos St. on the left.
- 5. Turn left on Idomeneos St. and walk for 200 meters till you see Olive Green in front of you.





DRIVING FROM EASTERN CRETE

Agios Nikolaos, Ierapetra, Siteia

- 1. Drive towards Heraklion on the national road E-75.
- 2. Approaching Heraklion take the first exit (to airport) to the city and turn left on the traffic lights.
- 3. Drive straight ahead for 4klm all the way across Ikarou Avenue.
- 4. At the very end the Archaeological Museum will appear right in front of you.
- 5. Turn left towards the city center and after 10 meters turn right to Idomeneos Street
- 6. Follow Idomeneos Street for 150m and Olive Green will reveal before you.

DRIVING FROM WESTERN CRETE

Rethimnon, Chania

- 1. Drive towards Heraklion on the national road E-75.
- 2. As you approach Heraklion, take the exit for the city through Thanasi Skordalou str
- 3. Continue on Thanasi Skordalou street and at the traffic lights turn left in Knossou Av.
- 4. Continue straight ahead, over the bridge, on Dimokratias Av. towards the center of the city.
- 5. Keep driving on Dimokratias Av. Until you reach Eleftherias Sq.
- 6. At the roundabout turn left towards the city center and after about 10 meters turn right in Idomeneos street.
- 7. Follow Idomeneos Street for 150m and Olive Green will reveal before you.

Archaeological Museum of Heraklion

The Archaeological Museum of Heraklion is one of the most important and significant museums in Greece. The museum was built between 1937-1940, and boasts 20 rooms with exhibits originating exclusively from Crete. The collections come mostly from central and eastern Crete, and cover a span of 5.500 years.

The exhibits are presented following the chronological evolution of the Minoan civilization. It is located in the center of the town just 100 meters from the Hotel

Historical Museum of Crete

The museum was founded in 1953 by the Society of Cretan Historical Studies. It is housed in a three storey neoclassical building, owned by the Kalokairinos family, and represents an important element of Cretan history and tradition. It comprises 12 rooms, showing the evolution of Cretan civilization, from the Christian period until the 20th century. Its collections include pictures, historical heirlooms, books, maps, Cretan costumes and many other exhibits depicting the Crete of the past.

Natural History Museum of Crete

In the Natural History Museum of Crete, visitors become familiar with the flora and fauna of Crete and mainland Greece. A key focus of the museum is to enable visitors to understand the relation between the old civilizations and the natural environment; to learn about the impressive past, and the future of Crete and the Mediterranean, through fossils, rocks and minerals.

Museum of Visual Arts

The Heraklion Museum of Visual Arts (METH) was established in 2000 by K. Schizakis and is a meeting place between artists and their publics. It is a place of intellectual development, education and entertainment. The museum hosts important art and culture events.

Koules Fortress

The Venice of the East, as it was described during the Venetian rule, Koules is the trademark of the medieval city of Heraklion. Koules Fortress was built in 1523-1540 offering a spectacular view to the Cretan Sea, and is the vigilant sentry that protects the city of Heraklion.





Tomb of N. Kazantzakis

The tomb of the most beloved writer of Crete is located on the southern part of the Venetian Walls, on the highest point of the Venetian fortification at the Martinego cavalier. Its wooden cross bears his famous quote: I hope for nothing. I fear nothing. I am free. Offering a view to the entire city of Heraklion, this landmark makes clear that no homage will ever be enough for this great man.

The Palace of Knossos

Knossos is the most important and majestic creation of the Minoan Civilization, a sacred cultural heritage of Greece, and a world renowned monument. Located 5 km southeast of Heraklion, the Minoan Palace of Knossos, expanding over a surface of 22.000 m2, is visited by thousands of tourists and locals every year.

St. Markus Basilica

St. Markus basilica is also located at Venizelou square and now used as: lecture hall, exhibitions, other cultural events and houses the municipal library too. Built by the Venetians in 1239. The Dukes used to attend the church services and also got buried there. From the entrance of the church the public herald announced (verbally) the Dukes' directives to the people.

Venetian Walls

The Venetian walls represent the most formidable project of Venetian rule. They were first built in the 15th century whereas extensions and improvements were carried out during the 16th and 17th centuries. The main architect was one of the famous army engineers of the 16th century, Michele San Michele of Verona. The perimeter has a length of 3 km reinforced with three ramparts which are still maintained. It has four gates: the pier gate at the harbour, the gate of Lazaretto, the gate of the Pantocrator or Panigra known today as the gate of Chania, and the fourth gate is on the south side called the gate of Jesus or new gate. Proceeding along the perimeter we reach the impregnable bastion of Martinego, the highest point on a peak where the walls meet forming a triangle into the peninsula. Here in lies the tomb of Nikos Kazantzakis (1883-1957) from where one can enjoy a panoramic a breathtaking view.

Morozini Fountain

This is situated in the center of Venizelou square, inaugurated by the Venetian administrator Francesco Morozini. Water issues from spouts in the mouths of four lions, dating from the 14th century, the decor of the eight troughs of the fountain consist of reliefs from scenes in Greek mythology on top of which is ensconced a gigantic statue of Poseidon holding his trident which unfortunately got destroyed during Turkish rule. The fountain was connected to the aqueduct (also constructed by Morozini) transporting waters from the Yuchta slopes to Heraklion.
